

THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF PORT HOPE

BY-LAW NO. 63/2011

Being a By-law to Amend By-law 43/2011 being a By-law to Establish the Youth Advisory Committee for the Corporation of the Municipality of Port Hope

WHEREAS Section 11 of the Municipal Act 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, in part provides that a lower-tier municipality may pass by-laws respecting the governance and structure of its local boards;

AND WHEREAS By-law 43/2011 was adopted by Council to establish the Youth Advisory Committee for the Municipality of Port Hope on March 29, 2011;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Port Hope deems it expedient to amend the composition of By-law 43/2011, establishing the Youth Advisory Committee for the Corporation of the Municipality of Port Hope to include two members who are residents and/or ratepayers of the Municipality, being a minimum of 18 years of age and not an employee of the Municipality;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF PORT HOPE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Section 5 of By-law Number 43/2011 be deleted in its entirety and replaced with a new Section 5 as follows:

Composition

That the Youth Advisory Committee shall consist of a maximum of eleven (11) members appointed by Council annually all being voting members as follows:

- maximum of 8 youth members (age 13 to 17) of the Municipality, including the Student Councillor, to be appointment for a one year term
- 2 members appointed by Council who are residents and/or ratepayers of the Municipality, being a minimum of 18 years of age and not an employee of the Municipality
- 1 member of Council appointed for the term of the appointing Council, or until their successors are appointed.

The Youth Advisory Committee shall report directly to Council for the Municipality of Port Hope.

Ex-officio

The Program Manager of the Department of Parks, Recreation and Culture or designate shall be an ex-officio member of the Committee who shall act in an advisory capacity and shall be a non-voting member.

2. That this By-law comes into force and takes effect upon the final passing thereof.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD time and finally passed in Open Council this 17th day of May, 2011.
