CIVIC AWARDS PROGRAM

Awards may be presented in the following category descriptions:

(a) Outstanding Citizen:

- nominee must be a resident of the Municipality of Port Hope who has made an outstanding long term volunteer contribution to the community.

- this award to be presented when warranted, may not be every year.

(b) Outstanding Youth:

- nominee must be a resident of the Municipality of Port Hope who has made an outstanding contribution to the community and their school, and who is 19 years of age, or less, as at December 31 in the year nominated.

- this award to be presented when warranted, may not be every year.

(c) Achievement:

- outstanding achievement in the Arts. (Art, music, public speaking, dance, creative writing, singing, visual arts and crafts, etc.)

(d) Service:

- nominee should have been involved in a project that has had a considerable impact on the community.

- nominee must have made a distinct contribution in making the Municipality of Port Hope a better place to live.

- nominee must have been an instrumental figure in the project.

- nominations for contribution to the environment will be considered under the service category.

- a group is eligible.

(e) Athletic:

- nominee must be an individual or team that won a provincial or higher, amateur championship during the previous year, and for other athletic achievements acceptable to the Committee, that has brought honour to the Municipality of Port Hope.

NOMINATIONS:

Awards for Achievement, Athletic and Service will be considered for non-resident nominees, if the individual or group has represented the Municipality of Port Hope, served, achieved, brought honour, or made a worthy contribution to the Municipality of Port Hope.

ELIGIBILITY:

Only individuals who have volunteered their time and service and/or competed at an amateur level and for which no remuneration or payment has been received shall be eligible for a civic award.

Nominations must be submitted by the end of business hours on January 8, 2010
