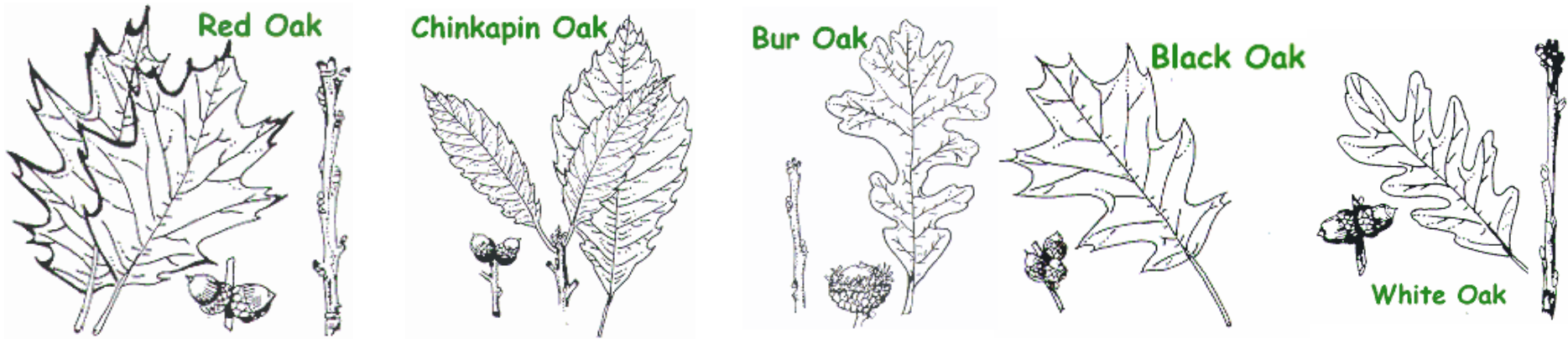

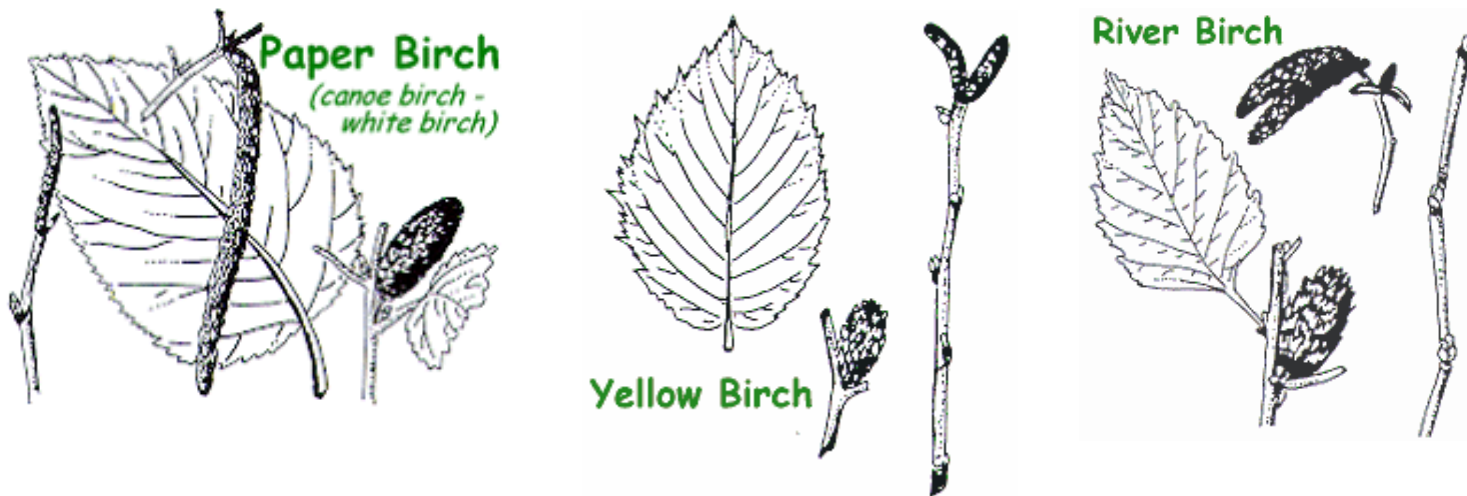
ALTERNATE BRANCHING – COMPOUND LEAVES



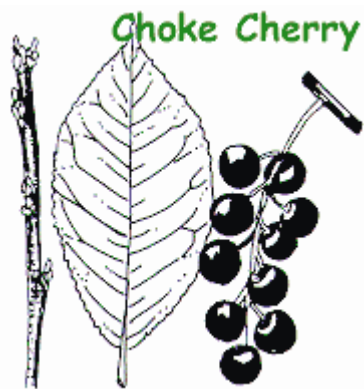
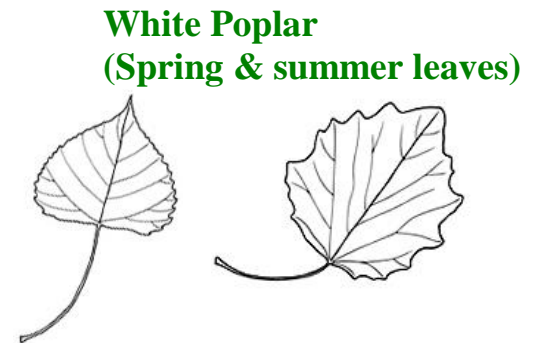
ALTERNATE BRANCHING – SIMPLE LOBED LEAVES

NON-LOBED LEAVES WITH FLATTENED STEMS



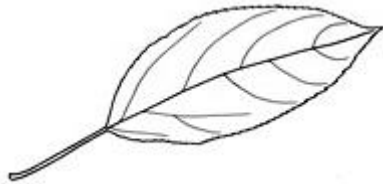

Only 2 lobed leaf

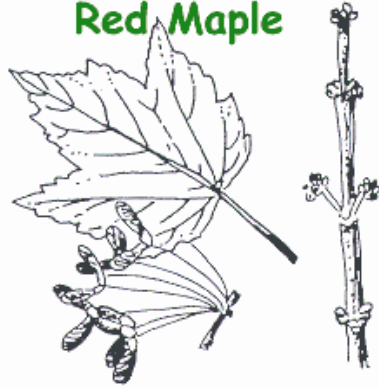

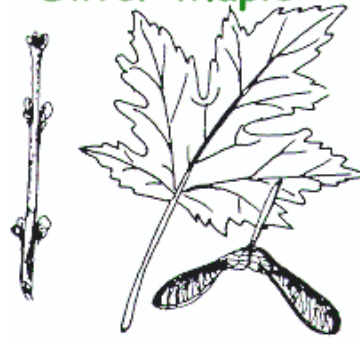

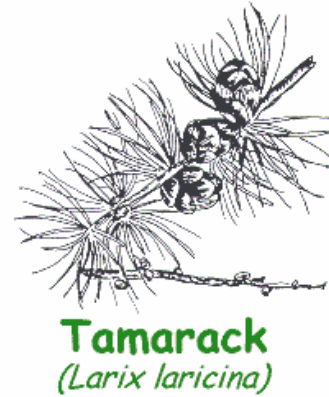
