## HOPE BY-LAW NO. 09/2023

## Being a By-law to adopt the 2023 Municipal Budget

WHEREAS Section 290 of the Municipal Act, 2001, requires that a local municipality shall, in the year or the immediately preceding year, prepare and adopt a budget including estimates of all sums required during the year for the purposes of the municipality; and

WHEREAS Section 39 of the Police Services Act provides that Council shall establish a Budget for the Police Services Board; and

WHEREAS Section 24 of the Public Libraries Act provides for Council to establish a Budget for the Library Services Board; and

WHEREAS Finance Committee met on January 31, 2023 and February 2, 2023 to review the 2023 Proposed Budget and has recommended that Council Approve the 2023 Municipal Budget as amended;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Port Hope hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. THAT the municipal budget estimates for the year 2023 as presented in Schedule "A" are hereby adopted;
- 2. THAT the municipal capital budget estimates for the year 2023 as presented in Schedule "B" are hereby adopted, the amounts for which are included in Schedule "A";
- 3. THAT the tax levy requirement to meet both the municipal operating and capital budget estimates for the year 2023 is \$24,342,585;
- 4. THAT the Port Hope Police Service Board be provided a 2023 operating budget of \$6,061,422 from Levy and a capital budget of \$158,264 from the Municipal Policing Reserve;
- 5. THAT the Port Hope Public Library Board be provided a 2023 operating budget of \$904,039 from Levy and \$20,000 from the Development Charges and \$35,500 from the Library Reserve;
- 6. THAT staff and boards are authorized to proceed in accordance with the approved operating and capital budgets;
- 7. THAT pre-budget approval be confirmed and provided for the purchase of two tandem axle snowplow trucks for a combined budget amount of \$730,000, as well as for the Transportation Master Plan for a budget amount of \$300,000.
- 8. THAT this By-law shall come into force the day it is finally passed.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD time and finally passed in Open Council this 7<sup>th</sup> day of February 2023.
