1. Please briefly describe the organization's programs and services:

Play Your Sport Northumberland is a camp that provides kids, adolescents and teens between the ages of 8-18, across Northumberland County the opportunity to play a variety of recreational activities. The activities that we provide to the public include soccer, baseball, tennis, basketball, volleyball and flag football. With our access to the lake we also provide the public the opportunity to swim, kayak, canoe, paddle board and play water polo. Play Your Sport Northumberland consists of 30 staff members and 20 volunteer members. Our camp is open to the public between May 1st – September 30th for our summer activities and our indoor gymnasium is open all year round. We continuously fund-raise and search for funding through sponsorships and grants. We also rent out our facilities to the public and clubs to obtain revenue to cover our costs. Since we do not have access nor own a rink, Play Your Sport Northumberland hosts a hockey tournament every year for kids, adolescents and teens between the ages of 8-18, across Northumberland County. Our hockey tournaments are hosted within each Town/Municipality on a rotated basis across Northumberland County so that we can accommodate residents from all over the Northumberland area. These tournaments are one weekend long during the month of January. We also rent school buses to shuttle the kids and families to and from the rinks. Because of the difference in ages, we divide the kids up by placing individuals from the ages of 8-11 together, 12-15 together and 16-18 together. If we are short in some age groups we do try and divide them up equally to make it fair. In addition, we raise money to purchase equipment and clothing for those families who cannot afford them. We have a set due date for when individuals from low income families can sign up for our hockey tournaments so that we can accommodate them by arranging their proper attire.

2. Please provide a statement of the organization's goals/objectives:

Play Your Sport Northumberland's goals are to provide kids, adolescents and young teens the opportunity to have fun and be active, while feeling healthy and enhancing their self-esteem. Our goal is to allow kids have the opportunity to engage with others, while enhancing their social interaction skills, and learn how to work as a team. Another goal of Play Your Sport Northumberland is to allow children, adolescents and young teens from low income families have the opportunity to participate in our events by providing them equipment and/or clothing that they may need and cannot afford.

3. If Council approves the organization's Community Grant request, what will the funding be used for?

If Council approves our Community Grant request the money will be used directly to benefit all of the kids, adolescents and young teens living amongst Northumberland County who want to participate in our hockey tournaments. The funding will be used for operating, administrative and program related expenses including hockey equipment and the transportation costs to shuttle the kids and their families to and from the ice rinks.

4. Please provide a description of how the organization intends to measure the success of the program or service:

One method that we are using to measure the success of our event is our social media platforms; Twitter, Instagram and Facebook. We always post on Twitter and Facebook at least three (3) months in advance prior to the hockey tournament to get the word out. We post once a week on Twitter and Facebook prior to the hockey tournament so that we do not bombard our followers. A week prior to the hockey tournament and during the tournament we encourage individuals to follow us on our social media platforms. We encourage them to Tweet and post on Facebook about their experience and to tag us by #playyoursport. We also encourage participants to post pictures of either themselves and their friends or the tournament on Instagram, along with tagging us by #playyoursport. This allows us to see if individuals are enjoying their experience, and it can help us gain more followers as well as increasing individuals' awareness about our program.

Our second method of measuring success is to provide every participant a survey after the tournament is complete. This survey consists of 15 questions asking about their experience, if they had fun, felt healthy, how they would rate their self-esteem, and if they felt the tournament enhanced their social interaction skills. This survey is completely anonymous, as it does consist of sensitive information and we would like to obtain the most accurate and truthful feedback from all of our participants. Each participant is to provide their survey to our office or can submit this to us via email.

Another method that we use to measure success is by having a couple of our volunteers stand at the registration booth and keep track of how many individuals attend by using mechanical tally counters. This way we are able to keep track of the number of attendees each year.

5. What is the approximate geographic audience demographic that you plan to target? (i.e. 300 Adults and 50 Kids: 75% Port Hope Residents)

We are trying to encourage kids, adolescents and teens between the ages of 8-18 years resident amongst Northumberland County to participate in our hockey tournament. We are hoping to have 20% respectively from each member municipality. Ideally we would like to have 17 players (for three shifts) for each hockey team. We would like to have a minimum of 4 teams per age group for the hockey tournament (Example: 4 teams of 8-11 year olds, 4 teams of 12-15 year olds and 4 teams of 16-18 year olds). This would make a minimum total of 68 individuals between the ages of 8-11, 68 individuals between the ages of 12-15 and 68 individuals between the ages of 16-18. The timing of each game will vary depending on how many teams we get. If we get a minimum of 4 teams for each age group we would be able to make our hockey games 60 minutes with two 15-minute intermissions. We are also always happy to accept any volunteers who are interested in helping us operate these events.

6. What new initiatives will the organization be doing in the upcoming year?

Last year our hockey tournament was one weekend long during the month of January and was a huge success! However this year, because it is Play Your Sport Northumberland's 50th anniversary we will be hosting the tournament for two weekends. To celebrate our 50th anniversary we will be hosting multiple draws for fun prizes and providing a FREE hot lunch each day. We also have a lot of sport venders coming out to provide individuals the opportunity to check out different sports equipment, healthy food and drink products. We also have health consultants to educate individuals on healthy activities and eating habits, and we also have Social Workers coming out to educate and coach individuals on how to enhance their social interaction skills and self-esteem.

Sport Chek, Play It Again Sports and National Sports assist us with arranging sport equipment at a discounted price for those individuals who can't afford them.

Cobourg's YMCA is working with us to lend some of their equipment.

The Rotary Club, Lions Club, Northumberland United Way and Fire Association are providing us fun prizes.

The Municipality of Port Hope, Township of Cobourg, Cramahe, Hamilton and Alnwick/Halimand have allowed us to rent out their arenas for our hockey tournaments.

8. Does the Municipality provide your organization other financial support? (i.e. fee waiver, etc.) If yes, please indicate the amount:

At this time the Municipality of Port Hope does not provide any additional financial support.

9. How is the organization decreasing reliance on Municipal funding?

This year Play Your Sport Northumberland is requesting from the Municipality of Port Hope \$500 less than last year's request. We have hosted a t-shirt sale and are currently starting to organize our bake sale as well. Our t-shirt fund-raising was very successful, we sold over 200 shirts for \$10 dollars each. We will be hosting a raffle draw at the tournament where our guests can buy tickets. Half of the money raised from this draw will be given to the winner while the other half will help assist with the event costs.

Play Your Sport Northumberland has gathered sponsorships and grants from all townships and municipalities within the Northumberland County. We have also received sponsorships from Celebrate Ontario grant, Canada Games fund, Cameco, ESCO, and banks including Scotia Bank and BMO.

Play Your Sport Northumberland had also applied to Canada's Engage Growth grant, Ontario's Youth Health grant and Ontario's Sport and Recreation fund, however we were not successful at obtaining this funding.

We do greatly appreciate the support from the Municipality of Port Hope. Last year we placed the Municipality of Port Hope's logo on our two large banners at our hockey tournament. We also mentioned the Municipality of Port Hope on air with all of our radio stations. As a thank you, again we will be placing two large banners with the Municipality of Port Hope's logo on it at our hockey tournament, as well as recognizing the Municipality of Port Hope on air with all of our radio stations. We will be posting the Municipality of Port Hope on air with all of our social media platforms and on all of our brochures.

Each year we have experienced an increase in the number of people who are signing up for our program, whether it is individuals who want to participate in our tournaments or wanting to volunteer, and we can't thank the Municipality of Port Hope enough for your continuous support!
