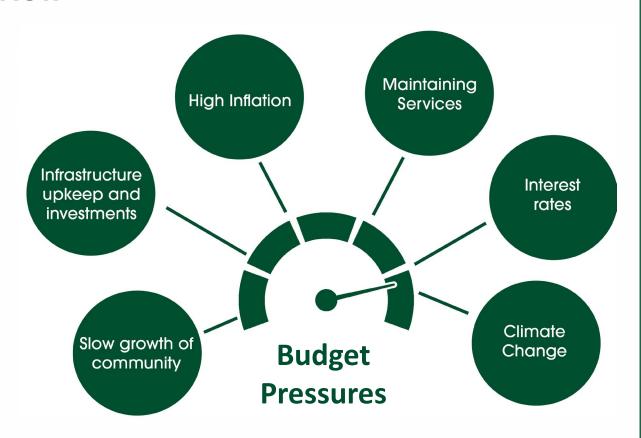

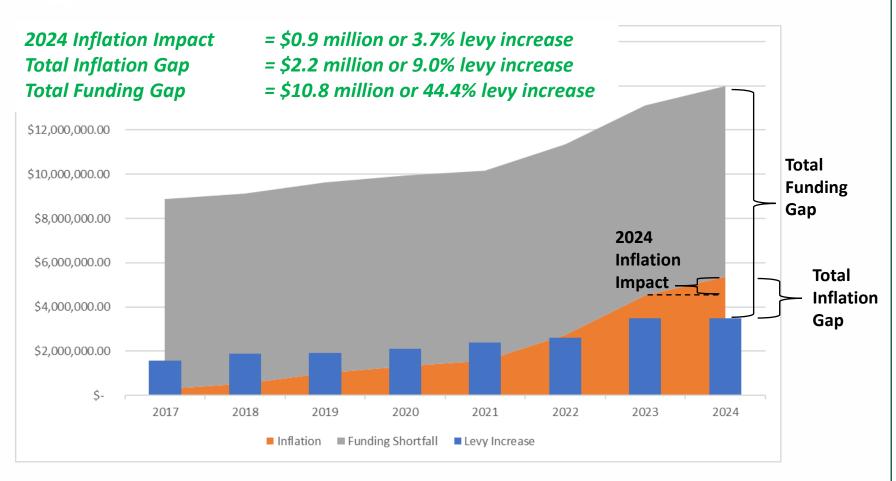

- Repairs and Maintenance on Vehicles 83.2% increase
- Fire Apparatus 16% increase over a 6-month period or \$1.3 million

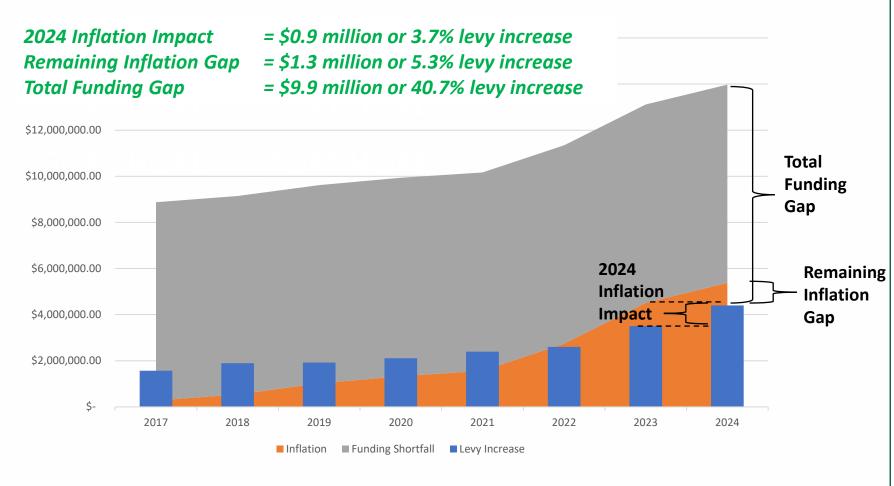


Inflation Impact – before 2024 Increase On Infrastructure Funding Gap (AMP 2016)

Infrastructure Funding Gap How to Improve

- Consistent levy funding increases every year vs. fluctuating increases
 - In years of high inflation don't get behind
 - In years of low inflation make improvement
- Improve Asset Management Planning to reduce long term costs of infrastructure
 - Often requires increased investment to design, initial quality, repair, maintenance, etc. in earlier life stages of infrastructure
- Reconsider Levels of Service
 - Reducing roads, bridges, park equipment, etc. reduces short and long term costs

Infrastructure Funding Shortfall Risks

- Increased maintenance costs
- Reduced service levels
- Likelihood of closures
- Increased need for infrastructure loans
- Increase in taxes to pay for infrastructure loans and maintenance
- Decrease in flexibility
 - Resource allocation challenges
 - Inefficient use of resources
- More vulnerable to impacts of climate change

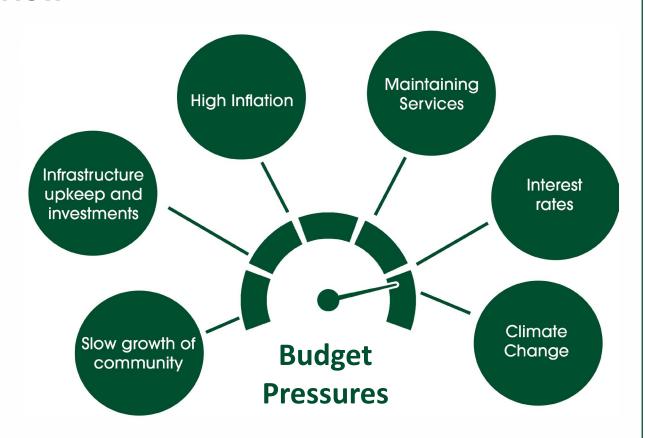
