Canton Cenotaph

The Canton Cenotaph is a sheltered, park like setting that encourages families, friends and visitors to pause and reflect on the sacrifice made by so many over the years.

Donation

The Canton Cenotaph was initially constructed in 1989 on the grounds of the Canton Municipal Building just north of the Village of Canton. A Cenotaph Committee was struck by the Municipality of Port Hope to be responsible for the following:

- To maintain the Canton Cenotaph as a lasting memorial
- To recognize all Veterans, from all Canadian and world conflicts regardless of country of origin including, but not limited to, the War of 1812, World War I, World War II, Korean War, Vietnam War, Gulf War, Merchant Navy, Native Veterans, POW/MIA, police and firefighters.
- To work in conjunction with Air and Sea cadets, schools and youth organizations to promote education and awareness.
- To plan, organize and be responsible for the annual Remembrance Day Service at the Canton Cenotaph.

Donations to the Canton Cenotaph can be a cash donation or through the Paver Program (see below).

Paver Program

Pavers will be offered in two styles
Individual Names or Uniformed Organization Emblems.

The Cost of each Name Paver is \$50.00

Your Individual Name Paver will be engraved with $\frac{3}{4}$ " letters with a maximum of 11 letters per line. A space equals 1 letter. There are a maximum of 5 lines.

The Cost of Each Emblem Paver is \$60.00

Your Uniformed Organization Paver will be engraved with an emblem and one line of lettering. A suitable copy of the emblem is required.
