

THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF PORT HOPE  
BY-LAW NUMBER 28/2002

**BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 3605 OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPE**

**WHEREAS** The Council of The Corporation of the Township of Hope enacted By-law 3605 on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2000 just prior to the creation of "The Corporation of the Municipality of Port Hope" authorize the execution of all documentation to appoint a trustee with respect to the Host Community Fee paid by the Federal Government pursuant to the Agreement for Cleanup and the Long Term Safe Management of Low-Level Radioactive Waste signed on behalf of The Corporation of the Township of Hope on December 11, 2002 and on behalf of Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Canada on March 29, 2001, hereinafter referred to as the "said Agreement";

**AND WHEREAS** effective January 1, 2001 The Corporation of the Township of Hope and The Corporation of the Town of Port Hope amalgamated and are now known as "The Corporation of the Municipality of Port Hope";

**AND WHEREAS** in 2001, the Royal Trust Company declined to act as Trustee as contemplated;

**AND WHEREAS** in the intervening months there has been communication with T.D. Canada Trust with a view to T.D. Canada Trust acting as trustee but no agreements have been concluded;

**AND WHEREAS** some of the provisions that the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Hope requested to be included in Schedule 8 of the said Agreement are not currently attainable;


**AND WHEREAS** the said By-law appointed the then Reeve, Ian Angus and Councillor Harry Boyton "to execute all documentation";

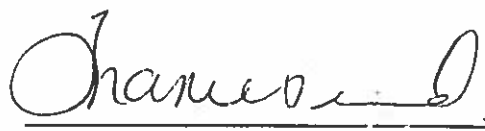
**AND WHEREAS** Council deems it advisable to appoint additional representatives for the Ward Two ratepayers to the implementation committee and to more clearly define the duties, authorities and obligations of those representatives;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Port Hope (hereinafter the "Council") enacts as follows:

1. That the committee of two created by By-law 3605 of The Council of The Corporation of the Township of Hope be continued and expanded as hereinafter provided.
2. That the committee be known as the "Ward Two Host Community Fee Committee" (hereinafter referred to as the "Committee").
3. That, subject to their respective approvals, Ian Angus and Harry Boyton continue to serve on the Committee together with Mayor Richard Austin, Councillor David Watson, and Councillor Linda Thompson and Marilyn Curson.
4. That the Clerk, Frances Aird, shall act as Secretary to the Committee.
5. That the Committee continue to exist until earlier of the Date the Trustee is appointed or November 30, 2003.
6. That the Committee shall meet and select a Chair and Vice Chair of the Committee as soon as possible and, in any event, within 6 weeks of the Date of Passage of this By-law.
7. The duties, authorities and obligations of the Committee are:
  - 7.1 to review draft trust documentation to implement "Township of Hope Fund" referenced in Schedule 8 of the said Agreement.
  - 7.2 to report to the Investment Committee of Council monthly.
  - 7.3 not to sign any contracts
  - 7.4 not to incur any expenses except in accordance with a Council approved budget.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and finally passed in open Council this 18<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2002.
